

# CRBIC-RULES



## **1. RIGHTS OF PARTICIPATION:**

1.1. Team and individuals of member federation which may be financial member or individuals of CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association shall participate in championship for award of medals/position.

## **2. ELIGIBILITY**

2.1. Individual/team members should be in possession of valid passport issued by authority of that participating nation—"Individual/ team members" belong to. Any individual/team member. if he is member of another national team, he must be resident for that nation for at least a year.

2.2. The individual member/member federation shall be permitted to participate in the championship. only upon production of declaration in the given format, which shall include, declaration.

## **3. MEMBER FEDRATION**

3.1. That participating member federation/member federation is in good financial position, shall bear all his/her/their expenses incurred on his/her illness/accident by themselves, Expenses of participating officials shall be bear by respective member federation.

## **4. DIVISIONS:**

### **4.1. NON-ASSISTED**

4.1.1. Individual or Team

4.1.2. Man and women

4.1.3. Sub Junior, Youth, Junior, Senior, Veteran

### **4.2. ASSISTED**

4.2.1. Man or women irrespective of any age group

## **5. CODE OF CONDUCT**

5.1. All the competitors (irrespective any division) will maintain harmony and good sports spirit in the event field.

5.2. In any case they will maintain to be non-violent.

5.3. All the competitors shall abstain themselves from using prohibited substances, procedures, follow prevailing laws and anti-doping policies.

5.4. The participating individuals, team shall not be refrain to wear advertising in additions to normal logos/ trademarks of the article being worn/ using equipments.

## **6. DRESS REGULATIONS**

6.1. Since, championship, being organized, are being witnessed usually by special delegates from various Organization, Governments, all competitors shall wear uniform in accordance to rules of CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association.

6.2. Women shall be allowed to wear full or short sleeves Shirts/T-Shirts full length Trousers or Shorts Should not be higher above knee.

6.3. Woolen wears shall be allowed in accordance to weather at the Time of competition/ceremony.

6.4. Men shall be allowed to wear full length trousers or shorts and full or short sleeve Shirts/T-shirts.

6.5. All the members shall wear enclosed footwear.

6.6. Track suit supplied to participating team as an official uniform shall be allowed to wear during competitions/ceremonies.

6.7. Competitor's registration no. given by organizing committee shall be worn by individual during shooting and that will be mandatory.

6.8. Competitors shall be allowed to use flag/emblem of nation country they represent, until the same obstructing organizing objective.

6.9. During competitions, No competitor shall be allow to wear, to use on their clothing any type of advertising/slogans/statements/or drawings.

6.10. During Competitions, competitors shall be allowed to wear an official emblem/decoration/flag of the country/nation they represent.

## **7. SPORTS CROSSBOW COMPETITIONS**

7.1. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association shall organize competitions among individuals, team vise, in accordance to following.

## **8. INDIVIDUAL**

8.1. There must be minimum of 3 individual competitor in any participating divisions of target crossbow competitions, failing which that division shall not be allowed to compete unless, a special permission granted by CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association officials at that time.

8.2. It will be the responsibility of individual competitors without a team manager to report to the organizing committee, while they will arrive and keep themselves informed by regular checking the information on notice board.

## **9. TEAM**

9.1. Three Individual Members shall constitute a team.

9.2. There must be at least one or more team to allow team competitions for each division. One member federation may enter with two or more team.

9.3. Member of one team, in no case, shall be a member of other participating team i.e. one member cannot participate in two or more participating team.

9.4. Each participating member federation team shall be represented by one team manager and one assistant team manager who may be a competitor or no-competitor. Team manager shall represent their team in all cases related to competition/Championship.

## **10. TARGET**

10.1. Before start of official practice for competition. Organizing committee shall conduct a draw for allotment of target (event wise) to competitors. The same shall be witnessed by Chairman of that competition. Technical director (representative or technical committee, Team managers and team officials).

10.2. Soon after completion of draw for event wise allotment of target, a list shall be displayed in this regard.

10.3. For all the part competitions of a particular event target number allotted through draw basis shall be fixed.

## **11. COMPETEITOR NUMBERS**

11.1. At each competition CRB organizing committee shall issue a participation reference number that shall be displayed on the back of each participating as individual or team.

11.2. The size of number shall be such that it must be visible from a distance of 100 meters (size shall be fit in a A-4 Sheet Le. 210 x 297 mm).

11.3. Competitors shall ensure to wear such allotted number at their back which must be visible during progress of shooting at all time.

## **12. ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDS**

12.1. Based on scoring of highest marks the award of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> winner shall be awarded.

12.2. Corresponding medal for each category shall be awarded along with a certificate.

12.3. Medal shall be Gold for 1<sup>st</sup> position, Silver for 2<sup>nd</sup> and Bronze for 3<sup>rd</sup> position.

12.4. Medals along with ribbons and certificate shall be supplied and cost shall be bear by the committee at the time of celebrations.

## **13. TECHNICAL COMMITTEE**

13.1. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association shall appoint Technical committee, comprising of one Technical Director, One Asst Director, at least two Technical Executives.

13.2. The Technical committee shall be responsible

13.2.1. To advise the organizers on CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association formulating rules and their implementation.

13.2.2. To inspect all facilities, equipment and venue during competitions.

13.2.3. To help in conducting draw for target allocation.

## **14. DOPING CONTROL**

14.1. The use of banned performance-enhancing drugs, commonly referred to as doping, which can aid performance and give competitors an unfair advantage, shall be totally banned in all competitions conducted by CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association.

14.2. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association is committed to promote doping free sports (Crossbow Shooting) for implementing international doping control policy during sports.

14.3. The reasons for the ban are mainly the health risks of performance-enhancing drugs, the equality of opportunity for athletes, and the exemplary effect of drug-free sport for the public.

14.4. Alcohol also shall be a banned substance during competitions conducted by CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association.

14.5. All the competitors taking part in competition shall agree and submit a written declaration in the pre defined format, confirming their awareness to CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association anti doping policy, control and its penalties.

14.6. Competitor's declaration forms shall be filled and signed by individuals and counter signed by officials/team manager and shall be submitted to host organizers of competitions.

14.7. Competitor shall be agree and co-operate official of host organizing committee to verify/certify for their conformity that competitor is not under doping effect.

14.8. The denial of doing so shall be considered to be as positive result of doping, without conducting test .

14.9. Any competitor/group of competitors/the entire competitors may be selected for doping test using Urine/ blood analysis or any other technique to detect any prohibited substance.

14.10. If any competitor found to be positive by test result or by denial to go through process of test, shall be put on sanctioned.

## **15. SANCTION AGAINST POSITIVE DOPING RESULT:**

15.1. If any competitor/Group of competitors found/recorded to be positive result either by test conducted or by denial to conduct doping test, as desired by committee/official of doping control group, he/they shall be sanctioned by the provisions of World anti doping code 2009.

15.2. An anti doping rule violation shall leads to disqualification of the result obtained in the competition with all resulting consequences, including forfeiture of any medals, point and prizes, in accordance to provisions in World Anti-doping. Code 2009.

15.3. If the contestant/establishes that he or she bears no fault or negligence for violation, the participant's individual result in the other events shall not be disqualify unless the participant's result in competitions other than the competitions in which the anti-doping rule violation occurred were likely to have been affected by participant anti-doping role violation.

## **16. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE OF JUDGES.**

16.1. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association shall appoint/constitute committee of judges. Among them CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association shall appoint One shooting Director, One Assistant shooting director and one or more support Shooting executives as deemed fit to the IFWC host committee. If availability of shooting judges felt to be low, committee may select shooting executives from available participant individual, participant teams. If so such participant shall not be debarred from taking part in shooting competitions and suitably adjusted to take part in competition and position of judges shall be replaced suitably.

16.2. Shooting director, Assistant Director shall be solely responsible for conducting Shooting program. They shall not be given any other task nor any of them took participate as a participant Shooting executive shall be involved in all the judging activities of field work.

16.3. Championship Committee Judges shall Co-operate with technical committee.

## **17. EQUIPMENT CONTROL:**

17.1. During competitions/championship equipment single pistol /crossbow along with sufficient quantity of bolt shall be kept with the participant. However, standby equipment (Pistol/Crossbow) of similar make and capacity may be kept in reserve. In case of equipment failure, defective equipment may be replaced by equipment kept in reserve.

17.2. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association will not have any liability to extend time for that round, or shall not allow participant to have extra time for that round against time taken for replacing equipment/repairing equipment. It will be sole responsibility of participant to keep his equipment in healthy condition.

17.3. Course adjustment in equipment shall not be allowed at the time of competition however, minor adjustment always shall be welcome to improve aiming performance. Course adjustment is required while equipment is new or

its aiming device removed and replacing with new one or replaced after repair/adjustment.

17.4. During Championship following equipment shall be allowed

17.4.1. PISTOL: - Self Loading Crossbow Pistol having draw weight 50 lbs to 130 lbs

17.4.2 CROSSBOW: - Recurve/compound crossbow having draw weight 150 lbs to 300 lbs.

17.4.3. Telescope but not distance finder, or laser pointer shall be allowed to use during shooting competitions.

## **18. ROUNDS & SCORING:**

18.1. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association shall have competitions/ championship in following events:

18.1.1. **PISTOL CROSSBOW**:- Pistol Crossbow shall be organized for Sub-junior, Junior, Senior, and Veteran for all Man & Women.

18.1.2. **SPORTS CROSSBOW**:-Sports crossbow shall be organized for Junior, Senior and Veteran for all Man & Woman,

18.1.3. **FOREST ROUND**:-Forest Round shall be organized for Junior, Senior, and veteran for all Man & Woman.

18.1.4. **3D Round**:- 3D shall be organized for Junior, Senior, and Veteran for all Man & Woman.

18.2. Event classification, distance from which shooting shall be done, marks of the round and total round in an event shall be as per table as follows:

## **19. PRACTICE:**

All the participant under practice session shall follow CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association rules of shooting, failing which such participant shall not be allow to practice and may also disqualify to participate for competitions for which practice, Session is going on.

### **19.1. Unofficial Practice**

19.1.1. Unofficial practice shall be performing one day earlier than scheduled program of the competitions championship under strict control of Director/ Assistant Director of shooting.

19.1.2. Participant shall be given time fifteen (**15**) minute. During this **15** minutes participant may shoot any numbers of bolt. After finish

of 3 minutes Stop whistle (or any other signal) shall be blown. Participant shall keep down their crossbow/ Pistol down and no other activity shall be made other than directed/ instructed by shooting controller.

## 19.2. Official Practice:

19.2.1. Official practice shall be done prior to start of event to allow participant to fine tune their crossbow/pistol before he/ she/ they enter in start of competition. Once competition start, in no case, shooting for practice/ for fate tuning/ for check of equipment shall not be allowed.

19.2.2. Participant shall be given time fifteen **(15)** minute. During this **15** minutes participant may shoot any numbers of bolt. After finish of 3 minutes Stop whistle (or any other signal) shall be blown. Participant shall keep down their crossbow/ Pistol down and no other activity shall be made other than directed/ instructed by shooting controller..

## 20. RECORDS:

20.1. CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association Director of shooting shall display SCORE of THE EVENT soon after the event completed.

20.2. SCORE obtained on individual/ team. Category basis shall be maintained for different level category wise.

20.2.1. NATIONAL LEVEL RECORD

20.2.2. INTERNATIONAL/ WORLD LEVEL RECORDS.

20.3. Old record break/crossover by new participant or by same participant shall be maintain separately by CRB-International Crossbow Shooting Association and shall be displayed on notice board by Shooting Director.

## **21. SHOOTING RANGE ARRANGEMENT:**

### **21.1. LAYOUT**

21.1.1. The width of shooting field/ground shall be sufficient to accommodate the entire target allocated to each participant in a view to give sufficient/ safe spacing between two participants.

21.1.2. The minimum ground width shall be equal to (Nos of participant+1) 1.8 Meter

21.1.3. Shooting lane shall be at perfectly perpendicular to target butt.

21.1.4. Shooting lane and distances to be marked clearly.

21.1.5. Participant, in a event having more than one distance length for shooting, shall be move their position for shooting from different distance, keeping target at fixed position.

21.1.6. Waiting line shall be market at 6 Meter away from shooting line.

21.1.7. Spectator line shall be at least 20 meter away from shooting line.

### **21.2. TARGET BUTT:**

21.2.1. The buttress is to accommodate target face; hence its dimension (height and Width) should be at least 4 cm higher than face. It is required to accommodate bolt going (reasonably) out of zone of scoring.

21.2.2. The center of target face shall be 1.5 Meter from ground surface.

21.2.3 Stand/ or any frame work use to support Target buttress should hard enough to hold the buttress and soft enough not to damage bolt if pass through the target buttress.

21.2.4. One wind flow indication to be used to show wind direction. It is to be mounting behind target buttress line and high enough to be visible to spectators sitting behind the line of shooting.

21.2.5. Target shall be numbered from left to right. Size digit should large enough to be made visible 20 meters away from distant line of event. Even numbers shall have white back ground and Number to be black in color. Odd numbers shall have black back ground with white color of the number.

## 21.3. TARGET FACE:

21.3.1. Target face shall be 80 x 80 cm.

21.3.2. It will divide in 5 equal distant rings from its center named Circle A to D from center. Each part shall be further divide by doted circular line.

21.33. The circle between centers to 1" dotted line shall be white with plus mark in its center. The outer part of Circle A shall be Golden/ Yellow in color.

21.3.4. Remaining Circle inner part shall be white and outer part shall be red, green, Violet, brown. All the separating line (Solid/ dotted) shall be black in color.

21.3.5. The white strip has been introduced to increase visibility of bolt on to the target face.

21.3.6. The score shall be marked 10 to 1 from inner to outer.

21.3.7. TARGET FACES can be made of paper Cloth, Plastic sheet or any other material. Target faces for a particular event shall be made of same material & color shade.

## **22. EQUIPMENT FOR CHAMPIANSHIP:**

22.1. Director of shooting shall be responsible for start and stop all the events during championship. He will be equipped with digital clock (enable to down counting) audible and/ or visual alarm/ signal.

22.2. Before start of championship director of shooting shall brief the participants about the signal which shall be used.

22.3. Manual signaling system (Audio/ Visual) like table bell, flag etc shall be available to meet any emergency, during failure of electrical equipment and/ or electrical system itself.

22.4. Mike system shall be available for better announcement. Battery operated announcement (handy mike) shall also be available.

22.5. Walkie- talkie system shall be available in sufficient quantity for better communication among Championship controllers and judges/ control desk.

22.6. One score board (minimum) shall be displayed for display of Participant score. It shall be updated soon after completion of round.

## **23. SHOOTING CONTROL:**

23.1. Director of shooting shall commence shooting after ensuring all safety measure completed.

23.2. Competitors shall be touching the shooting line only after command by shooting director.

23.3. No competitor shall span, load or raise or aim to target pistol/ crossbow unless he is standing on shooting line and directed

by director, failing which competitor shall be declared disqualified for the event immediately.

23.4. Competitors on their turn shall be allowed to stand on shooting line. All other competitors shall be on waiting line. Spotting telescope (not range finder) can be used by the participant, attached to a stand with prior permission with shooting director.

23.5. Participant shall be alarmed lapsed of time at least three times. Last alarmed shall be given 30 second prior to completion of particular round.

23.6. After completion of round director shall alarm to stop shooting. Competitors shall keep their shooting equipment down to stand/table and stand behind the equipment at distance of two meters.

23.7. After confirmation of completion of shooting of particular round, director shall allow to move participant to witness score with the judge of score.

23.8. Participant shall not allow to touch or to remove the bolt from target face.

23.9. If a competitor completes his/her/their shooting for that round before completion of time, he/ she/ they shall keep their shooting equipment down to stand/table and shall stand 2 meter behind the shooting line. He/ she/they shall raise (visual) signal, if provided.

23.10. No competitor or any other person shall be allowed to disturb the competitor. In emergency director of shooting may allow doing so.

23.11. In the event of equipment failure, participant shall keep his/her shooting equipment down to stand/ table. Come back

one step back and raise visual signal to attract attention of shooting director. He will allowed time for 5 minutes to repair/ replace with standby equipment, In such ease, participant may allow to shoot for 5 minutes only to accommodate time lapsed during repair/ replace of defective equipment.

## **24. SHOOTING POSITION**

- 24.1. If a competitor is physically capable, he will stand upright position touching shooting line by both legs parallel to each other, or touching one leg (Left leg) with shooting line and other leg (right) behind shooting (one step back) line and body inclined with target face.
- 24.2. If a competitor is physically challenged (Assisted shooter), he can shoot sitting on wheel chair/ stool in such a way that no part of body shall cross the shooting line.
- 24.3. Pistol can be picked/hold using both hand straight forward from the body or aiming such a way one hand can be used to support and one for shooting.
- 24.4. Crossbow butt touching to right shoulder. Left hand for supporting equipment and right for trigger control and holding but firmly to right shoulder.
- 24.5. Left handed persons shall reverse their position as stated above.

## **25. SCORING**

- 25.1. Director of shooting Shall have scoring sheet (Table- 1).
- 25.2. No competitor shall touch any bolt or target face or remove bolt from target face unless instructed by scoring judge/ director of shooting.
- 25.3. The position of number of bolt in given circle shall be recorded in the score sheet.
- 25.4. The center of target having sign of + is pin point.
- 25.5. If a bolt is shot at boundary/interfacing line of two color/ score category, the bolt touching/ intersecting/ cutting higher score shall be considered.
- 25.6. Bolt inserted in butt and not visible, the score shall be counted by director of shooting.
- 25.7. Bolt immersed in the hack of other bolt and available on target face both the bolt shall be counted and shall be scored accordingly. The immersing of bolt in to other bolt shall be kept by director shooting for reference.
- 25.8. Bolt shot by participant on to other competitor's target shall not be counted. Competitor received extra bolt from other participant shall not be considered and equal numbers of bolt score from highest shall be forfeited.
- 25.9. After scoring, director of shooting shall confirm that no bolt has been left on the target face.
- 25.10. Upon calculating score value, Director of shooting shall update score on the score board and keep record for future use.
- 25.11. If tying in score occurred during declaring final result, it will be decide following way




25.11.1. Nos of bolt strike in bull (pin point) of the target face.

25.11.2. Nos of bolt strike in Highest score zone of 10 (Yellow/gold)

25.11.3. Nos of bolt strike in zone of 9 score.

25.11.4. Else shall be declaring on common, equal.



# DEFINITIONS

## DEFINITIONS

- Arbalist/Arbalest** : Crossbow shooter is known as Arbalist/Arbalest.
- Assisted Shooter** : A Crossbow shooter who has disability which preventing them complying with general shooting rules.
- Bench** : A firm table/ platform which is being used to put crossbow and support the Bench prone Round.
- Bolt** : Projectile which is being shot from a crossbow.
- Latch** : It is a part of crossbow which holds string of a spanned crossbow.
- Category** : It is an event for which shooter is being compete.
- Clear Draw** : It is a power stroke and measured as a distance between braced string and the catch.

### CROSSBOW and ITS TYPES :-

- Crossbow** : A device which shoots a bolt.
- Target Crossbow** : It is a crossbow which is being designed/manufactured specially for shooting competitions.
- Crossbow-Recurve** : A crossbow which incorporates mechanical advantage where the limbs are interconnected using string only.
- Crossbow-Compound** : A crossbow whose limbs arc mechanically assembled using cable/string and eccentric wheels/cams.
- Crossbow-Medieval** : A crossbow similar to crossbow was used in medieval times.

- Division** : Competing area divided by age/ gender i.e. (Men, Boy, Girl) Senior, Junior, Assisted.
- Load** : It is an act of placing bolt in to a spanned crossbow.
- Prod** : It is a part of the crossbow which provides the force to propel the bolt.
- Range** : It is an area where target is being placed and shooting is being done
- Rebound** : A bolt which hit and bounced off the target.
- Span** : It is an act of pulling the string of a crossbow back and made ready for shooting.
- String** : It is a chord which interconnects the limb of crossbow.
- Target** : It is an object on which shooting is being done.
- Target Face** : It is a surface of a target which is used for aiming and Scoring point.
- Target Butt** : It is a material behind the target face used for Stopping a bolt.
- Target Stand** : A bar/A set of bars/Framework which hold target butt.
- Wind shock** : It is a Wind indicator flag fixed above the target level to indicate and judge the direction and force of wind.
- ROUND 3D** : A crossbow shooting competitions which utilize 3 dimensional target (Simulation of an actual).
- Doping** : Doping in sport, a term for the use or performance-enhancing drugs/substance in sport often to improve athletic performance.
